

Photography Tips

Take time to look before you start to photograph. What do you see that you haven't noticed before?



Try different angles - look up or photograph from above



Look for patterns or lines to make an interesting image



Move closer with your feet rather than using your zoom, if you can



Respect people's privacy. Don't photograph people close up without their permission



If you share your photos on social media, use the hashtag **#U1RPhotoWalk**

If you share your photos, you consent to Under One Roof using your images for the project publicity online and in print

TOP TIP
Spend time exploring around the church building and churchyard. Don't forget to look up at the tower, windows and gargoyles
